EKC Schools Trust have a sector-leading partnership with Colleges across the EKC Group, offering our children unique curriculum-enriching opportunities.

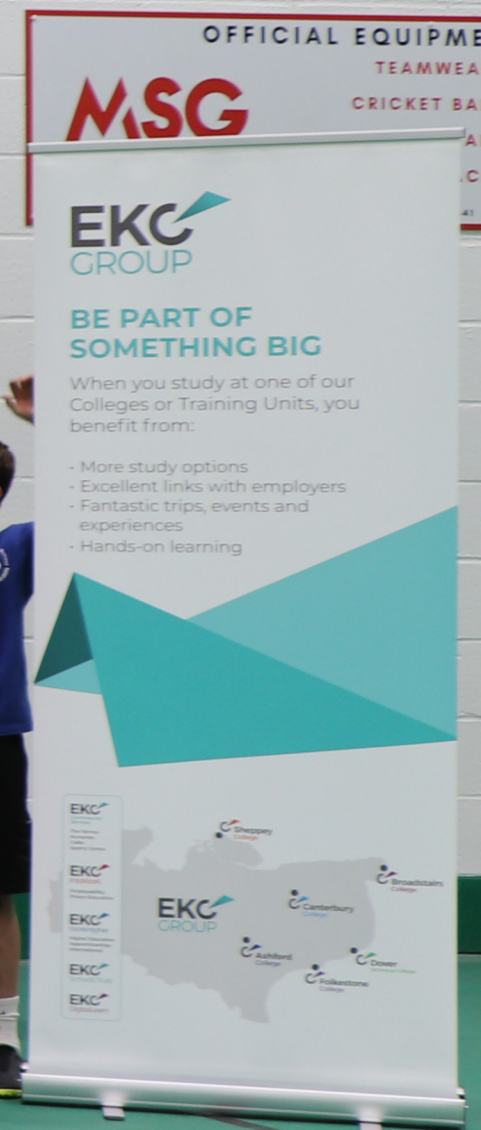
