Our cross-curricular topics will link to the school theme which is 'This is Me'.

Our Value this term is Respect. Please do talk to your child about what this means.

**Writing**—Our writing will be linked to the book 'After the Fall' by Dan Santat. We will be working on retelling the story.

We will also be looking at 'The Sea Book' by Charlotte Milner in guided reading.

### Our Topics for this Term

**Maths** - The children will be focusing on place value this term. They will be comparing and ordering numbers up to 1,000. They will also be partitioning numbers up to 1,000 in numerals and in words. Then they will be moving onto addition and subtraction.

**PSHE**— The children will be following the Likewise PSHE Programme. Details about our PSHE curriculum are on a separate leaflet.

**Art**— Our artwork will be based around the theme of 'This is me' and the children will be developing their drawing, painting and collage skills through Picasso.

**P.E/Games** —During our indoor PE sessions we will be learning gymnastics and we will build up to using the large apparatus at the end of term. In our outdoor sessions we will be doing OAA which will develop our team work and communication skills.

**R.E.** —The children will be learning about Sikhism.

**Geography**—We are learning about what a river is and will be locating and naming some main UK rivers.

**Science**—Our science topic is light and shadows.

**Computing**—The children will be learning about e-safety.

**Music** -The children will begin to learn a note on the recorder and play a song.

### Autumn 1 2025/2026

Your child needs to read for 20 minutes a night - 10 minutes with their school book and the other 10 minutes can be with any book of their choice. Parents must sign their child's reading record and comment if they wish. If your child is on RWI books they will keep the book for the week as before. **Please can the children bring their reading books to school everyday.**

Homework and spellings will be set on a Friday. They will have ten weekly spellings and will learn their multiplication tables on TTrock stars. We use a spelling game called Edshed which is web based and the children will play spelling games using the ten words they have been given. You will find their login for Edshed in the front of their reading record and your child has a TTrock stars log in too. They will be tested on their spellings and times tables on a Friday.

Our main PE session is Wednesday afternoon and if it is dry we will have PE on Friday afternoon. The children should wear their PE kits into school on Wednesdays (only) and they should come to school with their trainers or plimsolls on Fridays (with uniform).

**Water Bottles** - Children must have their own water bottle in school every day.
