<u>Topic</u>

Our topic for this term is Eco Warriors. We will be doing lots of geography and science work this term on exploring how we can help look after the planet and animals. We are looking forward to a trip to Asda Park on Friday 17th May. Where we will carry out a litter pick followed by a play.



English

The children will be continuing with Literacy or RWI lessons this term. Our book for this term is The Last Wolf by Mini Grey, the book takes a twist on the fairy tale Little Red Riding Hood. The story also links to our geography work on the impact of climate change and deforestation which will promote discussion. We will be exploring the book and completing a range of activities and writing around this.

This term we are going to continue our learning about fractions and finding fractions of amounts. We will be carrying out lots of practical tasks to support us with our learning with money and mass and capacity. We will also be learning about data handling, this includes tally charts, bar graphs and pie charts and we will use the computers to help us do this.

Geography

In Geography we will be exploring Antarctica and Brazil. Looking at where these places are, what animals live there and what life is like. We will then be comparing this to the UK to explore the similarities and differences between these countries.

Science

This term in science we will be linking our learning to Geography and we will be carrying out some experiements to observe and predict what we think we will happen and have discussions around the experiments, these will link to climate change, recycling, endangered animals and rainforests. One of these experiments will link to our learning on Anartica and explore melting and freezing.
