ENGLISH— This term we will be looking at the classic narrative 'The Selfish Giant' by Oscar Wilde. We will be recognising archaic language, using personification to describe weather, seasons and items found in the garden, all building up to retelling this classic narrative from a character's point of view.

MATHS - This term we will be focusing on ratio and the relationship between ratio and fractions. After we have completed our SATS practise week we will move on to look at algebraic equations.

PSHE - We will be looking at a range of topics in PSHE, starting the term looking at autism and moving on to look at the power of speech and the things we say.

R.E. — The religion we will be exploring this term is Christianity. We will be exploring the question: 'Is anything ever eternal?' Through this we will discuss and explore Christian beliefs on life after death.

SCIENCE - In Science this term, we will be learning about living things and their habitats. Through this work, we will describe how living things are classified according to common observable characteristics, similarities and differences, as well as classify plants and animals ourselves.

PE - This term we will be continuing with Dance for our indoor PE lessons on Tuesdays. This time we will be looking at how movements, gestures, contrast, variation and formations can demonstrate tensions in relationships between performers. For our Thursday outdoor PE lessons, we will be participating in football where we will be developing set up shooting opportunities for teammates as well as restrict opponent's space through defending.

HISTORY and GEOGRAPHY - For History and Geography this term, we will be studying the Ancient Mayan Civilization. The geographical location and environment of where they lived will be explored as well as who they were, when they lived, how they lived and important changes/developments made by the Maya that affect life today.

FRENCH - In French this term, we will continue our learning around vocabulary relating to schools and refining our knowledge of time.

MUSIC - Our Music learning this term will centre around singing Benjamin Britten's Friday Afternoons: 'A New Year Carol'. It will challenge our ability to change pitch (singing high and low) and texture (the quality of the sound).

COMPUTING - In computing this term, we will be exploring technology in our lives. Children will understand computer networks, including the internet; how they can provide multiple services, such as the World Wide Web, and the opportunities they offer for communication and collaboration. They will use search technologies effectively, appreciate how results are selected and ranked, and be discerning in evaluating digital content.

ART - Our Art focus this term is Texture and Colour. Using our topic theme and these art concepts, we will develop our artwork.
