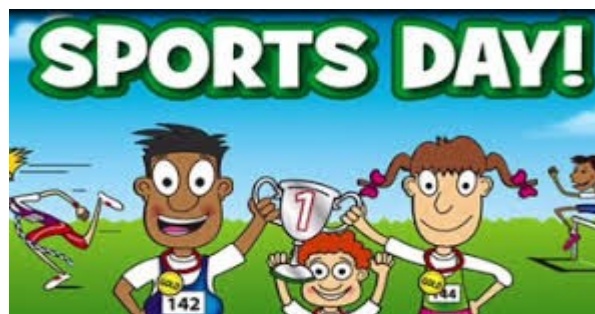


Wednesday 23rd June Towers Transition to be at the Towers school for 12.30pm and collected at 2.30pm from the Towers.
