
Welcome back to Term 5 in year 3. We hope you all had a lovely Easter holiday, and you are ready for the new term. Our topic this term is

In a World of Imagination



ENGLISH — We are reading a picture book called 'Journey' by Aaron Becker this term. The children will write an adventure story at the end of term based on this. Our class reader will be 'Tilly Mint Tales' by Berlie Doherty. The children will develop their writing skills, including: grouping ideas in to paragraphs, using prepositions, conjunctions and adverbs, using a or an correctly and showing an awareness of purpose through selecting vocabulary carefully.

MATHS - The children will be learning about fractions, length. They will explore making and recognising equal and unequal parts using both real life objects and pictorial representations. The children will extend their knowledge of the whole and halves to recognise quarters and thirds of shapes, objects and quantities. The children also be learning to read measurements of mm, m and cm.

SCIENCE - We will also be learning about skeletons and muscles -focusing on the functions of skeletons and muscles in animals and humans. We will be learning about the right types and amount of nutrition needed by both animals and humans.

DT - We will be designing and making healthy sandwiches.

MUSIC - Learning to play the recorder. Singing - Bring
Us together (Genre- Disco)

P.E/GAMES — Athletics and Cricket. We will be practicing different athletic events and learning how to play Kwik cricket.

GEOGRAPHY- We are looking at where our energy comes from, we will be looking at renewable energy and sources of electricity.

Each child needs to read for 20 minutes a night - 10 minutes with their school book and the other 10 minutes can be with any book of their choice. Parents must sign their child's reading record and comment if they wish. Reading levels will continue to be reviewed. Homework will be on Edshed. They will have ten weekly spellings and will learn their multiplication tables. We use a spelling game called Edshed which is web based and the children will play spelling games using the ten words they have been given. The children can practice their times tables using TTRockstars. They will be tested on their spellings and times tables on a Friday and you will receive your child's results the same day.

Our indoor PE session is Monday afternoons and outdoor PE is Friday afternoon. The children only need to come to school in their PE kits on Mondays. Please can they wear trainers or plimsolls with their school uniform on a Friday.

A reminder that PE kit should be your child's house coloured top or a white polo with navy/black shorts or jogging bottoms, full school uniform should be worn all other days.

Please could your child bring a named water bottle to school, especially as the weather is getting warmer.
